

Fee Waiver Eligibility

The College Board SAT and ACT provide fee waivers, 2 per test for high school students in their junior and senior year. One of these waivers will be used for the SAT School Day in October for seniors. To be eligible, students must meet one of the following qualifications below and provide evidence:

- Family receives public assistance as in The Food Stamp Program or Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) in which the households must pass a gross income limit less or equal to 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL).

- The family is unhoused or resides in federally subsidized public housing or a foster home. Evidence must be documented.
- Student is a ward of the state or an orphan.
- Annual family income falls within the Income Eligibility Guidelines set by the USDA Food and Nutrition Service. Please provide evidence by submitting the **1040A Income Tax Form, must have the student's name as a dependent.**

To determine income levels for families with more than 6 household members, take the annual allowance for 6 members, \$74,518 and add \$9,509 for each additional member.
